Notes of Explanation on Gift Aid Donations

1. If your declaration covers donations you make in the future:
 - please notify the Church Office and planned Giving Officer if you change your name or address while the declaration is still in force
 - you can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying the Planned Giving Officer – it will then not apply to donations made on or after the date of cancellation or such later date as you specify.
2. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that St Matthew & St Oswald (m2o) PCC reclaims, you can cancel your declaration.
3. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief on your Self Assessment tax return.
4. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid relief, ask the Planned Giving Officer of St Matthew & St Oswald PCC (m2o). Or you can ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 Gift Aid.
5. Your Gift Aid donations will be treated in strict confidence.
6. After completing your Gift Aid Declaration form, please return it to the Church Office or post it in the Church Centre Post Box at the back of church.
